Your Legislative Action Committee at Work

At the Federal level, your Chapter's Legislative Action Committee (LAC) is preparing to attend the NAIOP Chapter Leadership & Legislative Retreat on Feb. 5-7 in Washington D.C. to meet with

representatives on Capitol Hill to voice NAIOP's concerns on critical legislative issues.

Tess Brandwein, LAC Chair, participated on a conference call with Rex Hime, CBPA and others to discuss the proposed Split Roll Tax. Under the proposal all business properties will be

reassessed to 2020 values and will be reassessed every three years thereafter. Commercial property will lose any certainty and one can only imagine the impact and cost to long time property owners. Your Legislation Action Committee will continue to work with CBPA to oppose this attack on Prop 13 and will keep you updated.
